

Resurvey E. Bdy T18NR37E.

Chains south on E. bdy. of T. 18 N., R. 37 E. bet. secs. 1 and 6. At 40.00 Chs. I make careful search for the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. which I am unable to find. I continue my retracement south and at 80.00 Chs. search diligently for the old cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12 and of which I can find no traces, therefore I continue my line south setting temp. points at intervals of 40.00 Chs. and making diligent search at these points for the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. and sec. cor. At 399.70 Chs. I intersect E. and W. line 25 lbs. E. of the old cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, which is a granite stone 16 x 8 x 7 ins., marked with 5 grooves on the north and 1 groove on the south edge, laying in a mound of earth.
