Aug. 28, 1913 At 8^h 45^m.
 a. m., l. m. t. I set off 39°
 22' N. on the lat. arc; 9° 45'
 N. on the decl. arc; and determine
 a meridian with the solar alt
 the cor. of Gps. 17 and 18 N., R. 37
 and 38 E. lat. 39° 22' N., Longitude 117° 46' W.

Thence I run
 West on true line along S. body
 sec. 34

Over rough mountainous land,
 descend 275 ft.

15.00 Ravine, course N 45° W., asc.
