

Subdivision of T. 18 N., R. 37 E.

Chains

Sept. 19, 1913

N<sup>o</sup> 1' E on a true line bet. secs. 2 and 3.

9.47 Over mountainous land, ascend crest of ridge, bears N. 80° W. and S 80° E. Descend through pines

21.98 Descend abruptly 200 ft.

30.00 Canyon course west, ascend along W. slope, scattering pines

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cov. with brass cap mkd.:

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and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cov. No trees near for marking

59.00 Crest of ridge, bears E. and W. desc.

73.00 Canyon course W. ascend barren slope

79.65 Intersect N. Bdy. of Tp. 5.88 Chs. N. 89° 52' E. of the cov. secs. 34 and 35; T. 19 N., R. 37 E. previously described. At the point of intersection I build a cov. as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for closing cov. of secs. 2 and 3 with brass cap mkd.:
