

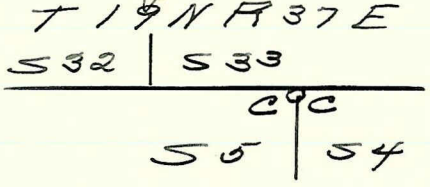
Subdivision of T. 18 N., R. 37 E.

Chains

61.00 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.  
Old wood road, bears S 75° E  
and N 45° W.

78.80 Intersect N. body of Twp. 8.75 Chs.  
N. 89° 00' E. of the cor. of secs.  
4, 5, 32 and 33 which is an  
iron post previously described  
I obliterate the marking on the  
cor. referring to secs. 4 and 5,  
destroy the pits in these secs.  
and change the mound of earth  
N. of cor. thus making it a cor.  
of secs. 32 and 33 T 19 N R 37 E.  
only. At the point of intersection  
I build a cor. as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long,  
2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground,  
for closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5  
with brass cap marked;

dig pits, 24 x 18 x 12 ins., E. and  
W., 3 ft., and S of cor., 7 ft. dist.;  
and raise a mound of earth,  
4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, valley, sloping N.W.  
Soil, sandy and gravelly washed loam;  
4 to 8 ins. deep, rocky subsoil; 2nd pit  
Undergrowth, sage and desert brush.  
small growth, bunch grass  
no timber
