

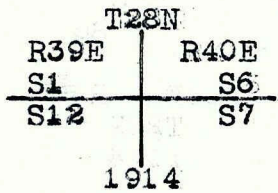
Survey of the east bdy. of T. 28 N. R. 39 E.

Chains..

62.30 Bend of ridge, 265 ft, above canyon, bears ^N W. and ^W SE.

Continue asc.

80.00 Set iron post 3 ft.. long, 3 ins.. in diam. 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap marked



and raise mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, west of cor.

Soil, 3rd rate, ^agrvly loam:

Sage brush and bunch grass.

Timber, juniper.

Drains SE. to 16.20 chs. thence NW.

Mountainous land 80.00 chs.

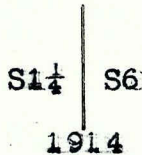
N. on true line bet. secs. 1 and 16, over mountainous land through dense sage brush. Grad. asc.

18.00 Ridge, 65 ft. above cor. brs. SW. and NE.

35.80 Road, brs, S. 25° W. and N 25° E.

36.40 Creek, in bottom of the north fork of Galconda Canyon, creek is 2 lks. wide, 3 ins. deep, course S. 25° W. 150 ft, below ridge, asc.

40.00 Set iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam. 26 ins. in the ground for the 1/4 sec.cor., with brass cap mkd.



and raise mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high west of cor.

Miners cabin brs. S. 45° E. 90 lks. dist.

Corral brs. S. 60° W. 1.50 chs dist.

82.63 1160 ft. above 1/4 cor., intersect the S. bdy. of T. 29 N. R. 40 E. 3.40 chs. east of the cor. of Tps. 28 and 29 N. R. 40 E. here-to-fore described. I destroy all marks pertaining to the township south, and at my intersection set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam. 12 ins.
