

## Subdivision of T. 28 N. R. 39 E.

Chains..

- 47.50 Spur, 150 ft. high, bears N. and S., desc.
- 56.40 Gulch, 125 ft. deep, course N. 15° W., asc.
- 79.93 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, 270 ft. above gulch.  
Soil, heavy clay loam except in canyon where it is a sandy loam.  
Sage brush and bunch grass, good grazing.  
No timber.  
Drains SW. to 28.80 chs., thence N.  
Mountainous land 79.93 chs.
- At 11h 44m a.m. l.m.t. I set off 13° 21½' S. on the decl. arc and observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting lat. is 40° 19' N.
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- Knowing that this line will not close within limits I run N. 0° 03' W. on true line bet. secs. 4 and 5.  
Over mountainous land through dense sage brush, desc.
- 17.40 Road, bears N. 75° W. and S. 75° E.
- 22.60 Wash, 1 ch. wide, 2 ft. deep, in mouth of Golconda canyon  
550 ft. below sec. cor., course N. 75° W., asc. W. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia. 26 ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

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and raise mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high west of cor.

- 58.90 Wire fence, bears N. 75° E. and S. 75° W. for 4 chs.  
thence west.

- 80.70 Intersect N. bdy. 2.60 chs. east of the cor. of secs. 32 and 33, cor. point falls in a wash 15 lks. wide 5 ft. deep, course NW., therefore at

- 80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia. 24 ins. in ground for witness cor. to the closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, with brass cap marked
