

Survey of the East Boundary of T. 6 N., R 69 E.

Chains

Land, rolling.

Soil, sandy to gravelly, with little or no loam; dry.

Subsoil, a sandy clay.

Timber, a scattering growth of cedars with a few piñon pine. Undergrowth, sage and other desert brush.

Timbered land, 40.00 chd.

North, on E. bdy. sec. 12. Over gently rolling land;
with drainage, generally N.E.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the
ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.:

dig pits, 18x18x12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft.
dist.; and raise a mound of earth, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft.
high, W. of cor.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the
ground, for cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass
cap mkd.:

and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high,

Land, gently rolling.

Soil, sand, gravel and clay mixed; no loam; dry. Subsoil,
clay and sand.

No timber; sage, and other desert brush.

North, on E. bdy. of sec. 1. Over gently rolling land;
drainage, generally N.E.

24.60 Dry Wash, 7 lks. wide, course E.

40.00 set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the
ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.;
