Survey of Subdivisions in T.35 N., R.46 E.

Chains

- 44.50 Ridge, bears NE. and SW. Desc. NW. slope.
- 50.10 Ravine, course SW.
- 50.30 Cliffs, bear NE. and SW., 30 ft. high.
- 59.50 Small ravine, course S. Asc. SE. slope.
- 63.80 Low mountain spur, slopes S. Desc. westerly slope.
- 74.81 Intersect the W. bdy. of the Tp. at S.2°8'W., 3.16 chs. from the cor. of secs. 30 and 31.

Set a basalt stone 19x11x4 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 30 and 31, mkd. CC. on E. with 1 groove on S. and 5 grooves on N. face, and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, E. of cor.

Land; E. 35.00 chs. is rolling land; W. 39.81 chs. is rolling, volcanic mountains, with a general slope to the SW.

Soil; rather poor quality, rocky and gravelly. Quite dry. Coarse texture, 3rd and 4th rate.

Fair growth sagebrush, not much grass, no timber.

From the cor. to secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32,

I run

N.0°01'W. on true line bet. secs. 29 and 30.

- 14.20 Ascend.
- 20.40 Top of low ridge, bears S.75°W. and N.75°E. Descend.
- 34.50 Draw, course S.45°W. Ascend.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for ¼ cor. of secs. 29 and 30, with brass cap mkd:

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 dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of post 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 3½ ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

- 71.20 Top of spur, nose bears S.45°W. Descend.
- 80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30, with brass cap mkd:

| S19 | S20 |
| S30 | S29 |

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land low rolling mountains.

Soil, sandy, 2nd rate.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and bunchgrass.

No timber.

The above mile was examined on Aug.24, 1914, by U.S. Surveyor Winfred A. Pray, and found correct.

Nov. 3. From the cor. to secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30,

I run

S.89°57'E. on a random line bet. secs. 20 and 29.

- 40.00 Set temp. ¼ sec. cor. point.
- 80.30 Intersect N. and S. line at cor. to secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29. Thence I run
- 27.20 N.89°57'W. on a true line bet. secs. 20 and 29.
- Dry wash, 10 lks. wide, course S.45°E.
- Ascend gradually.
- 40.15 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in the ground for ¼ cor. of secs. 20 and 29, with brass cap mkd:
