

2. Resurvey of Fractional W. bdy. T. 36 N., R. 46 E.

Chains dig pits 18x18x12ins., N. and S. of post 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 3 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.
 From the above cor., I continue retracing N., but after diligent search, fail to find any 1/4 sec. or sec. cors. until at
 121.41 Fall 85 lks. W. of the cor. to secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, which is a 20x12x5 ins. granite stone set in a mound of stone, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
 The course of this line is therefore S.0°24'W.

From the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, I run S.0° 24'W. bet. secs. 25 and 30.

RESURVEY OF SUBDIVISIONAL LINES IN T.36 N., R.46E.

From the cor. to secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, I retrace E. on blank line along N. Fract. Bdy. and after diligent search fail to find any old 1/4 sec. or sec. cors. until at
 320.22 Fall 2.44 chs. N. of the cor. to secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27, which is a 26x12x12 in. granite stone, mkd. and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
