Chains Thence/I run
 N. 89°45'W. on a true line between secs. 29 and 32.
 Ascending.
 36.80 Cliffs, 20 ft. high.
 40.14 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 10 ins. in
 the ground to bedrock, in a mound of stone for 1/4 cor.
 of secs. 29 and 32, with brass cap mkd:

 Over W. slope of volcanic mountains.
 Asc. steep south slope.
 Ridge, bears E and W. Descend NW. slope.
 Desc. over cliffs 20 ft. high, bears NE. and SW.
 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 24 ins. in
 the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., for sec. 29, with brass
 cap mkd:
