The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.

Land; rolling mesa, on N.E. slope of low mountain.

Soil; poor quality, coarse texture loam; from a few ins. to a ft. in depth. Underlaid with a firm clay subsoil or with a volcanic bedrock. 3rd. rate.

Good growth sagebrush, little grass.

S 0°12' W, bet. secs. 33 and 34.

Over high rolling mesa.

11.00 Ridge, bears E. and W. Desc. steep, rocky, S. slope of mountain. Desc. 170 ft. to

27.50 Rim rock, bears E. and W. Desc. over rimrock, 280 ft. to

36.10 Ravine course S.W. Asc. 70 ft. to

40.00 Point for cor. falls on rock in place, 8-6-3 ft. above ground. Cut (x) at cor. point with $\frac{1}{4}$ along side and raised a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor. Asc. 30 ft. to

42.00 Rocky mountain spur, slopes W. Desc. over steep, rocky, S.W. slope; over cliffs and slide rock. Desc. 800 ft. to

85.55 Intersect the S. bdy. of the tp. at N 88°41' W, 3.62 chs. from the cor. of secs. 3 and 4.

Set a basalt stone, 18-14-12 ins.; 12 ins. in the ground for cor. of secs. 33 and 34; mkd. with 3 notches on each of the E. and W. edges, and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high N. of cor.

Land; N. 11.00 chs. is high, rolling mesa, sloping to the N. S. 74.55 chs. is steep, rocky, S.W. mountain slope.

Soil; N. 11.00 chs. is poor quality, coarse texture loam, dry, shallow and rocky. 3rd. rate. S. 74.55 chs. is slide rock and rock in place. Very little soil. 4th. rate.

Practically worthless.

On N. 11.00 chs. is good growth sagebrush, little grass.

On S. 74.55 chs. is very little vegetation.
