## Chains

Soil; The E. 6.40 chs. is slide and rim rock, very little soil. 4th. rate.

The W 74.68 chs. is level mesa, with a fair quality, medium texture soil, from a few ins. to a foot in depth; underlaid with a firm rocky subsoil; and this underlaid with a volcanic bedrock. 2nd. rate.

Good growth sagebrush, little grass, no timber.

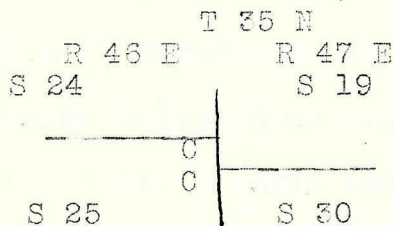
W. bet. secs. 19 and 20

Over level mesa, sloping to the N.E.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 15 x 8 x 6 ins. 11 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor. for sec 20, mkd.  $\frac{1}{2}$  on the S face dig pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. E. and W. of stone 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base.  $1\frac{1}{2}$  f. high S. of cor.

82.66 Intersect the W. bdy. of the tp. at S  $0^{\circ}40'W$ , 1.00 ch. dist. from the cor. of secs. 24 and 25.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 19 and 20, with brass cap mkd.



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dig pits 24 x 18 x 12 ins. , crosswise on each line, N. and S. 7 ft. dist. and E. 7 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high E. of cor.

Land; level mesa, sloping slightly to the N.E.

Soil; fair quality, medium texture desert loam; from 1 to 2 ft. in depth. Underlaid with a firm rocky subsoil and this underlaid with a volcanic bedrock. Quite dry. 2nd. rate.

Good growth sagebrush, considerable grass, no timber.
