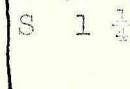

Set an iron post 7 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.

dig pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. N. and S. of post 3 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high

E. of cor. This cor. will be regarded as a witness cor. situated 1.37 chs. S.  $0^{\circ}04'W$ . of true point for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. for sec. 1. Descend gradual N. slope.

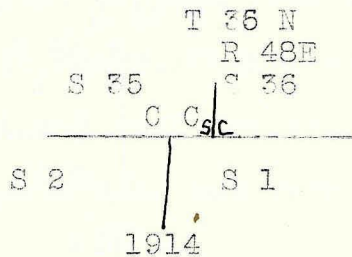

Set an iron post 7 ft. long, 2 ins. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for closing corner of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap mkd.



dig pits 24 x 18 x 12 ins. , crosswise on each line, E. and W. 3 ft. and S. of post 7 ft. dist. and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high S. of cor.

Land; rolling land, low ridges and draws.

Soil; fair quality loam, medium texture, from a few ins. to a foot in depth, derived from the disintegration of lime and volcanic rocks. Contains considerable gravel and rock.
