At the standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32, on the S. bdy. of the tp. at 8 h., a.m., l.m.t., I set off $40^{\circ}56'N$ on the lat. arc. $17^{\circ}7'N$. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar.

Thence I run

N $0^{\circ}19'E$, bet. secs. 31 and 32.

Ascending over rolling land.

9.30 Wash, course S.E. 25 ft. above sec. cor.

32.50 End of low spur, slopes S.E. 150 ft. above wash.

Thence along slope to the E.

40.00 On slope to the E.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam. 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.
