RETRACEMENT OF THE EAST BDY. OF T. 30 N., R. 42 EAST

Retraced by H.W.Reppert:-

June 23, 1914: At 8h. 30m. a.m., l.m.t., I set off $40^{\circ} 30' N$. on the lat. arc; $23^{\circ} 27' N$. on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the closing corner of Tps. 30 N., Rs. 42 and 43 E., heretofore described.

Thence I retrace.

South bet. secs. 1 and 6.

41.87 Intersect E. and W. line, 16 lks. W. of pits and mound of earth, which is a piece of decayed post in center of a mound of earth, marks not legible.

Course of this $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is S. $0^{\circ} 14' E$.

Continue retracement along same line.

81.89 Intersect E. and W. line, 33 lks. W. of the old cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, which is a willow post, 2x2x36 ins. long, set 10 ins. in the ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

The course of last $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is S. $0^{\circ} 14' E$. and the distance is 40.02 chs.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, I retrace South bet. secs. 7 and 12.

40.06 Intersect the E. and W. line, 17 lks. W. of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 7 and 12, which is a willow post, 2x2x26 ins. long, lying along side pits and mound of earth, Post is marked $\frac{1}{4}$. Piece of the old post is in the center of the mound of earth.

Course of this $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is S. $0^{\circ} 15' E$. I continue my retracement along same line.

80.06 Intersect E. and W. line, 35 lks. W. of old cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, which is a willow post, 2x2x26 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General. The course of the last $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is S. $0^{\circ} 15' E$.

From the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18 I retrace south bet. secs. 13 and 18.

40.04 Intersect the E. and W. line, 21 lks. W. of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of secs. 13 and 18, which is a willow stake, 1x2x26 ins. long, set 10 ins. in the ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

The course of this $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is S. $0^{\circ} 18' E$. I continue my retracement along same line.

80.15 Intersect the E. and W. line, 32 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, which is a willow post, 2x2x26 ins. long, set in a mound of earth, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

The course of the last $\frac{1}{2}$ mile is S. $0^{\circ} 10' E$. and the distance is 40.11 chs.

From the old corner of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, I retrace south bet. secs. 19 and 24.
