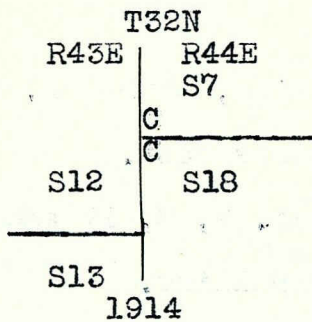


Subdivisions of T. 32 N., R. 44 E.

Chains

68.90 Bottom of gulch, course N. 45° E.; ascend.
 83.20 Gulch, course S. 60° E.
 83.71 Intersect The west boundary of the township, 2.12 chs.
 N. of the cor. of secs. 12 and 13, T. 32 N., R. 43 E.
 which is an iron post hertofore described. At the point
 of intersection I build a cor. as follows:
 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 12 ins. in the
 ground and in a mound of stone for the closing cor. of
 secs. 7 and 18, with brass cap mkd.:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high,
 E. of cor.

Land, rolling.

Soil, gravelly and rocky loam, 14 ins. deep, rocky clay
 subsoil.

Undergrowth, sage and desert brush.

No timber.

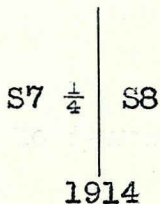
At this cor. I set off 22° 10' N. on the decl. arc; and
 at 6h. 5m. 10s., p.m., l.m.t., observe the sun on the
 meridian, the resulting latitude is 40° 38' N.

N. 0° 03' W. bet. secs. 7 and 8.

Over rolling land, draining east.

.35 Wash, 20 lks. wide, course S. 80° E.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the
 ground for the ¼ cor. of secs. 7 and 8, with brass
 cap mkd.:
