- 23.30 Large ravine, course N. E. 25 ft. below ridge.
- 29.40 Wash, course S. E. 70 ft. above ravine.
- 40.00 On E. slope of hill 250 ft. above wash.
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in
the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,
