Since both the N. and S. bdy. of this tp. are out of limits in either alinement or distance, it will be necessary to run a sectional correction line. I now begin at the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36; on the E. bdy. of the tp. and at 9h., a.m., l.m.t., set off 40° 25' N. on the lat. arc; 15° 32' S. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar.

Thence I run

W. bet. secs. 25 and 36, running a sectional correction line.

Over level land.

18.30 Electric power line from Beowawe to Buckhorn, bears somewhat N. E. and S. W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Fair growth sagebrush and greasewood, some salt grass, no timber
