At the standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the S. bdy.
 of the tp. at 10h a.m., l.m.t, I set off $40^{\circ} 30' N.$ on
 the lat. arc, $18^{\circ} 8' S.$ on the decl. arc and determine a
 meridian with the solar.
 Thence I retrace
 N. bet. secs. 35 and 36
 40.00 I search diligently, but find no $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
 80.00 I search diligently, but find no cor. for secs. 25, 26,
 35 and 36.
 I set temp. cor. for secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.
