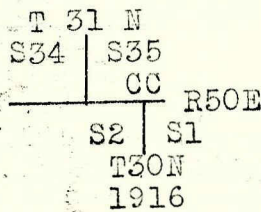


Chains

- 21.30 Top of spur, 55 ft. above hollow, bears N.20°E.
Desc.
- 29.50 Bottom of hollow, 130 ft. below spur, course N.20°E.
Asc.
- 33.20 Top of spur, 40 ft. above hollow, bears N.20°E. and
S.20°W.
Desc.
- 38.34 No trace of the original closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2,
can be found after diligent search.

This point satisfies the requirements of the propo-
rtion for the proper position of this corner as out-
lined in "Supplemental Special Instructions for the Survey
of Corrective Work in Group 27, Nevada." dated March 8,
1916, as amended by the Commissioners letter E-WCH, dated
March 30, 1916. Therefore, at this point

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins.
in the ground, for the closing corner of secs. 1 and 2,
with brass cap mkd:



dig pits 24x18x12 ins. crosswise on each line, E. and
W. 3 ft. and S. of cor. 7 ft. dist., and raise a mound
of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.

- 39.20 Head of Hollow, 45 ft. below spur, course N.20°E.
Asc.
- 42.60 Top of spur, 20 ft. above hollow, bears N.15°E.
Desc.
- 50.00 Bottom of hollow, 80 ft. below spur, course N.10°E.
Asc.

- 52.26 1/2 Mid point on the S. side of sec. 35.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins.
in the ground for the 1/4 sec. cor., on the S. side of
Sec. 35, with brass cap mkd:

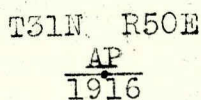


and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high,
N. of cor.

- 58.60 Top of spur, 60 ft. above hollow, bears N. and S.
Desc.
- 89.32 Point 325 ft. below spur.

This point satisfies the requirements of the propo-
rtion for the proper position for the cor. of secs. 35
and 36 (angle point corner) as outlined in "Supplemental
Special Instructions for the Survey of Corrective Work in
Group No. 27, Nevada," dated March 8, 1916, as amended by
the Commissioner's letter E-WCH, dated March 30, 1916.

No trace of the original cor. of secs. 35 and 36 can
be found after diligent search; Therefore, at this point
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins.
in the ground for angle point, only, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high,
N. of cor.

Land, mountainous, rolling.
Soil, gravelly and rocky, from 1 to 2 ft. deep. Subsoil
the same, but harder.
Undergrowth, sagebrush.
Good grass for grazing.
No timber.
