

## Retracement of S. Bdy. of T. 32 N., R. 50 E.

## Chains.

The course of this mile is S.87°09'E., and the distance 77.10 chs.  
November 16:

At this corner, at 11 h 45 m, a.m., 1. m. t., I set off 18°40' S. on the decl. arc; and observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting lat. is 40°32' N. which is correct.

Thence S.87°09'E. on the S. Bdy. of sec. 33.

39.39 Fall 2 lks. N. of an old mound of stone; but I am not able to find a marked stone as there is no other evidence of stone. I regard this as the point of the original  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

The course of this half mile is S.87°07'E., and the distance 39.39 chs.

Thence I continue my line S.87°09'E.

78.09 Fall 5 lks. N. of the original cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, which is a few small pieces of decayed willow stake with no marks visible, lying in a mound of stone. No other evidences of the corner visible. I regard this as the original corner of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34. The course of this half mile is S.87°07'E., and the distance 38.70 chs.

I destroy this cor. on May 19, 1916, in accordance with instructions from the U. S. Surveyor General for Nevada, dated April 6, 1916.

Thence S.87°09'E. on the S. Bdy. of sec. 34.

40.00 No trace of original  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

78.38 Fall 2 lks. N. of the original cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, which is a willow stake  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ins. in dia., 3 ft. long, in a mound of stone, with trace of markings visible but not plain enough to make out the lettering. The course of this mile is S.87°08'E. and the distance 78.38 chs.

November 16, 1914.

May 19, 1916. I destroy this cor. in accordance with instructions from the U. S. Surveyor General for Nevada, dated April 6, 1916.

November 17:

At 8 h 0 m, a.m., 1. m. t., I set off 40°32' N. on the lat. arc; 18°49' S. on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the original cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35.

Thence S.87°09'E. on the S. Bdy. of sec. 35, on a retracement.

40.00 Find no trace of original  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

78.00 Fall 70 lks. S. of the original cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, which is a granite stone 12X12X3 ins. in an old mound of stone, with 5 notches on the W. and 1 on the E. The course of this mile is S.87°40'E., and the distance 78.00 chs.

May 19, 1916. I destroy this corner in accordance with instructions from the U. S. Surveyor General for Nevada, dated April 6, 1916.

Thence East on the S. Bdy. of sec. 36.

40.00 No trace of original  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

78.26 Fall 45 lks. S. of the original cor. of Ts. 31 and 32 N., R. 50 E., which is a granite stone, 17X12X10 ins., marked with 6 notches on the N., S. and W. faces, with pits NW. and SW., and a mound of stone and earth W. of cor. The course of this mile is N.89°40'E., and dist. 78.26 chs.
