

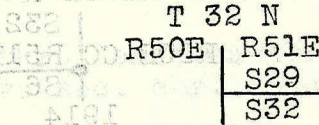

Thence S.0°50'W. on the E. bdy. of sec. 25.  
Over mountainous land.

Ascend on SE. slope of spur, through sagebrush.  
Intersect the original cor. of secs. 29 and 32, which is a granite stone, 12X16X24 ins., marked 5 notches on N. and 1 on S., lying in a mound of stone.  
I remonument the cor. as follows:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 29 and 32, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, E. of cor.

Thence S.0°38'W.

Spur, 100 ft. above hollow, projects S.80°E., desc.

Hollow, 70 ft. below spur, course S.50°W., asc.

Ridge, 60 ft. above hollow, bears N.30°E. and S.30°W., desc.

Intersect the original ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 25, which is a basalt stone, 10X16X18 ins., marked ¼ on the W. face, lying in a mound of stone. I remonument the cor. as follows:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 25, only, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

Thence south.

Spur of ridge, 60 ft. below top of same ridge mentioned, projects S.50°W., desc.

The original ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 32, which is a basalt stone, 6X12X24 ins., marked ¼ on W. face, lying in a mound of stone. I remonument the cor. as follows:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 32, only, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, E. of cor.

Thence S.0°19'W.

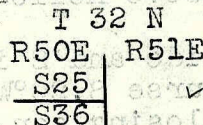

Hollow, 170 ft. below spur, course S.70°E., asc.

Intersect the original cor. of secs. 25 and 36, which is a volcanic stone, 10X12X14 ins., marked with 5 notches on the N. face and 1 notch on the S. face, lying in a mound of stone. I remonument the cor. as follows:

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 25 and 36, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor. This cor. stands on the top of a ridge, bearing N.50°W. and S.50°E., 80 ft. above hollow.

Land, mountainous, draining SE.

Soil, rocky clay loam, 3rd. rate, with the same subsoil.

Undergrowth, sagebrush.

No timber. Good grass for grazing.

Thence S.0°27'W. on the E. bdy. of sec. 36.

Over mountainous land, through sagebrush, desc. gently.
