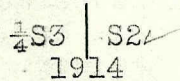


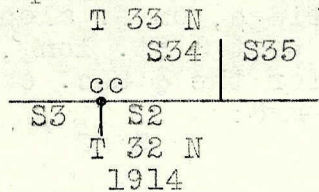
Chains

62.20 Canyon, 530 ft. below ridge, course S., asc.  
 80.20 Point 580 ft. above canyon.  
 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11, heretofore described.  
 Land mountainous.  
 Soil, rocky clay loam, with same subsoil, 3rd rate.  
 No timber.  
 Undergrowth, dense sagebrush, good grass for grazing.  
 Drainage S.  
 November 25: At this cor., at 11 h 47 m., a.m., l.m.t.,  
 I set off 20°41'S. on the decl. arc, and observe the sun  
 on the meridian, the resulting latitude is 40°37'.

Thence N.0°01'W. between secs. 2 and 3.  
 Over mountainous land.  
 Ascend on SE. slope of ridge, thru dense sagebrush.  
 19.00 Ridge, 220 ft. above sec. cor., bears N.20°E. and S.20°W.,  
 desc.  
 40.00 80 ft. below ridge on steep W. slope.  
 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 12 ins.  
 in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone,  
 for the ¼ sec. cor. for secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap  
 mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high,  
 W. of cor.  
 59.50 Canyon, 240 ft. below ridge, course S.30°W., asc.  
 89.31 Point 800 ft. above canyon.  
 Intersect N. Bdy. of the Tp., 14.17 chs. dist. West  
 of the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, heretofore described.  
 At point of intersection, set an iron post 3 ft. long,  
 2 ins. in dia., 16 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and  
 in a mound of stone for the Closing Corner of secs. 2  
 and 3, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high,  
 S. of cor.  
 Land mountainous.  
 Soil, stony clay loam, with same subsoil; 3rd rate.  
 No timber.  
 Undergrowth, dense sagebrush, good grass for grazing.  
 Drainage; S. 19 chs. SE.; N. 70 chs. SW.

Ruban W. Riley.  
 November 24: At 8 h 0 m, a.m., l.m.t., I set off 40°33'  
 on the lat. arc; 20°24'S. on the decl. arc; and determine  
 a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33  
 and 34.  
 Thence N.0°2'W. between secs. 27 and 28.  
 Over mountainous land.  
 Desc. on NW. slope of spur, thru dense sagebrush.  
 2.60 Hollow, 5 ft. below cor., course S.30°W., asc.  
 31.65 Top of broad ridge, 140 ft. above hollow, bears N.20°E.  
 and S.20°W., thence across top of ridge.  
 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in  
 the ground for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 27 and 28, with  
 brass cap mkd:
