NOTE: - On account of natural obstacles I am unable to set the post more than 18 ins. in the ground.
Bob Creek Canyon, 80 ft. below ridge, course W., asc. along W. slope of ridge.

89, 91

asc. along w. slope of ridge.
Intersect the N. Bdy. of the Tp. at a point N. $89^{\circ} 49'$ W.
13.89 chs. dist., from the re-established corner of secs.
31 and 32, heretofore described.

At point of intersection, set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 14 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone for the closing corner of sec. 5 and 6, with brass cap. mkd:
