Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 31, only, with brass cap mkd:

40.00 Find no trace of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. after diligent search.

80.00 Find no trace of the old cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33 after diligent search, therefore, at this point

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the re-established cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, with brass cap mkd:
