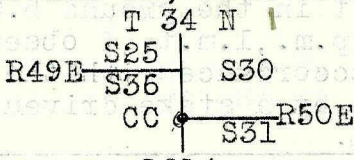

 Over nearly level land, thru dense sagebrush. Asc.
 5.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course W.
 12.00 Leave wash, course N.80°W.
 30.50 Old road, bears N.40°E. and S.30°W.
 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in
 the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd:



dig pits 18x18x12 ins. E. and W. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and
 raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.
 46.00 Wash, 16 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course S.80°W.
 78.67 Fall 202 lks. S.0°26'E. of the cor. of secs. 25 and 36, re-
 established for T.34 N., R.49 E.

At point of intersection set an iron post 3 ft. long,
 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing
 corner of secs. 30 and 31, with brass cap mkd:



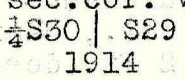

 idian with the solar; the resulting latitude is 40°46'N.

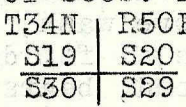
North on a Sectional Guide Meridian bet. secs. 29 and 30.

 S.84°W.

9.50 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course W.
 17.20 Old road, bears E. and W.
 21.00 Wash, 10 lks. wide, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. deep, course W.
 27.00 Old road, bears N.80°E. and S.80°W.
 30.70 Wash, 15 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course W.
 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in
 the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
 From this corner a wire corral bears S.71°30'E.
 40.45 Lincoln Highway, Battle Mountain to Carlin, bears N.78°20'W.

 Soil, clay loam and gravelly; 2nd rate.
 Subsoil, clay and gravel. Subsoil about 12 ins. below surface.
 Undergrowth, sagebrush, The land to the west is suitable
 for dry farming.
