October 13, 1914:

At 7 h 46 m, a.m., l.m.t., I set off  $40^{\circ}45'N.$  on the lat. arc;  $7^{\circ}33'S.$  on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35.

Thence East on a true line between secs. 26 and 35.  
Over mountainous land; through dense undergrowth.

3.50 Ravine, 30 ft. below cor., course S.  $20^{\circ}W.$  Asc.  
 10.50 Spur, 130 ft. above ravine, bears N. and S. Desc.  
 17.50 Hollow, 10 ft. below spur, course S.  $20^{\circ}W.$  Asc.  
 20.70 Spur, 50 ft. above hollow, bears N. and S. Desc.  
 27.70 Ravine, 35 ft. below spur, course SW. Asc.  
 36.80 Saddle on spur, 225 ft. above ravine, bears N. and S.  
 40.00 On east slope of ridge, 75 ft. below top.
