- 64.14 Top of ridge, 220 ft. above hollow, bears NE. and SW.
Desc.
70.50 Swale, 80 ft. below ridge, course S.10°W. Asc.
73.20 Spur, 220 ft. above swale, bears NW. and SE.
Desc.
79.98 The cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27.
150 ft. below spur.
Land mountainous.
Soil, gravelly and rocky; 2nd and 3rd rate.
Undergrowth, sagebrush. Good grass for grazing.
No timber.
October 14, 1914:
At this corner, at 11 h 46 m, a.m., l.m.t., I set off
8°02'S. on the decl. arc and observe the sun on the mer-
idian; the resulting latitude is 40°46'N.

- East on a true line between secs. 23 and 26.
Over mountainous land, thru dense sage; desc. abruptly.
5.50 Hollow, 100 ft. below corner, course S. Asc.
10.00 Top of ridge, 80 ft. above hollow, bears NE. and S.20°W.

24.30 Pacific States Telephone and Telegraph line (new) bears
N.28°45'E. and S.65°W.
25.00 Road and wash, 14 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, in bottom of
Welches Canyon, 350 ft. below ridge, course S.65°W.

39.00 Top of ridge, 350 ft. above canyon, bears N.20°W. and
S.20°E. Desc.
40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in
the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

44.00 Hollow, 25 ft. below ridge, course N.30°W.

63.00 Ridge, 400 ft. above hollow, bears N.70°E. and S.70°W.
Desc.
63.75 Intersect E. Bdy. of the Tp., at 10.49 chs. N. of the
cor. of secs. 30 and 31, on the W. Bdy. of T.34 N.,R.51 E.,
At point of intersection, set an iron post 3 ft. long,
2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the Closing
Corner of secs. 23 and 26, with brass cap mkd:
