

4. Retracement 7th Standard Parallel N., thru R. 50 E.

Chains

341.50 Thence East from this corner, setting temporary corners at 40 and 80 chs. from the W.  
 Intersect East Bdy. of T.35 N., R. 50 E., at N.0°55'E., 12.88 chs. from the cor. of secs. 6 and 7, heretofore described, as re-established in resurvey of the W. Bdy. of T.35 N., R. 51 E., and later made an A.P., for description of corner see resurvey of W. Bdy. of T.35 N., R.51 E.  
 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the Std. Tp. C.C. of T.35 and 36 N., R.50 E., with brass cap mkd:

September 14:

At 9 h 0 m, a.m., l.m.t., I set off 40°54' on the lat. arc; 3°35'N. on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the Std. Tp. C.C. of T.35 and 36 N., R. 50 E., and run West on a resurvey of the N. Bdy. of T.35 N., R. 50 E., setting corners at proportional distances.  
 West on a true line on the S. Bdy. of sec. 34.  
 Over rough, mountainous land.  
 Ascend on E. slope of ridge, through dense sagebrush.

13.75 Top of ridge, 210 ft. above corner, bears NE. and S., desc.

27.50 Ravine, 150 ft. below ridge, course NE., into Jack Creek.

40.16 Top of broad ridge, 250 ft. above ravine, bears N. and S. descend.

49.25 Ravine, 150 ft. below ridge, course N., ascend.

53.66 110 ft. above ravine on E. slope of divide ridge.  
 At proportional distance, set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for the Std. ¼ Sec. Cor., with brass cap mkd:

54.85 Divide ridge between Maggie Creek and Little Boulder basin 20 ft. above ¼ cor., bears N. and S., desc.

68.00 Ravine, 294 ft. below divide, course NW., asc. on N. slope of ridge.

83.25 Spur, 80 ft. above ravine, projects N., thence along N. slope of spur.

90.00 Spur, projects NW., desc. over rocky soil.

94.78 125 ft. below spur.  
 At the proportional distance, set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the Std. Cor. of Secs. 33 and 34, with brass cap mkd:
