September 14:
At the Std. Cor. of Secs. 31 and 32, at 11 h 56 m,
a.m., 1.m.t., I set off 3°32' on the decl. arc; and
observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude
is 40°54', which is correct.
Thence West on the S. Bdy. of Sec. 31.
Over mountainous land.
Ascend on E. slope of ridge, through dense sagebrush.
39.00 Divide ridge, between Little and Big Boulder Basins,
350 ft. above sec. cor., bears S.30°E. and N.50°W., thence
across bridge.
41.12 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in
the ground for the Std. ¼ Sec. Cor., with brass cap mkd:
