

8. Resurvey and Retracement of W.Bdy.T.35 N.,R.50 E.

Chains

There are no visible marks except the faint outline of an S on one face, all others being obliterated. I regard this stake as the old original cor. of secs. 20, 24, 25 and 29. I remonument the corner as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in a mound of stone for the cor. of secs. 24 and 25, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Note: On account of natural obstacles, it is impossible to set the corner in the ground.

- 40.05 Thence retracing South between secs. 25 and 29. Fall 24 lks. E. of an old willow stake, $1\frac{1}{2}$ x $1\frac{1}{2}$ by 30 ins. long, lying in a mound of earth, with faint outline of pits.
- 80.69 Fall 30 lks. E. of an old willow stake, 2x2 by 36 ins. long, lying in a mound of earth. No trace of pits.

- 40.00 Thence retracing South between secs. 32 and 36. No trace of old cor.
- 81.59 Fall 38 lks. E. of an old willow stake, 2x2 by 34 ins. long, with the letter T, R and S visible on two faces of the stake, all other marks obliterated, lying in a mound of earth with faint traces of pits. I regard this stake as the original corner of Tps. 34 and 35 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E., and remonument the corner as follows:
- Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the Tp. Cor. of T. 34 and 35 N., Rs. 49 and 50 E. with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

- 40.795 From the Tp. Cor. just established, Thence N.0°16'E. between secs. 32 and 36 on a resurvey of W. Bdy. T.35 N., R. 50 E. Over rolling land. Ascend gently through dense sagebrush. Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Note: Knowing I will set a C.C. on this boundary for the Tp. to the east, I mark all posts for the Tp. to west.
