and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.
 Note: From this corner, a spring in Sheep Creek Channel bears S.24°22'W., 10.86 chs. dist., claimed by D. Berning.
 43.80 Small draw, 15 ft. below spur, course SW., asc.
 48.00 Small wash, 10 ft. above draw, on S. slope of spur, course S. into Sheep Canyon.
 80.14 The cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21.
 Land, rolling mountains.
 Soil, light clay loam, with same subsoil; 2nd rate.
 No timber.
 Undergrowth, dense sagebrush, good grass for grazing.
 General drainage; S. into Sheep Canyon, thence W.

40.00 West on a true line between secs. 17 and 20.
 Over rolling land.
 Descend on S. slope of spur, through dense sagebrush.
 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

 Foot of mountains, enter Boulder flat, bears N. and S., 100 ft. below sec. cor.
 62.33 Intersect W. Bdy. of Tp., at 2.47 chs. S.0°36'E. of the cor. of secs. 13 and 24, heretofore described.
 At point of intersection, set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the Closing Corner of secs. 17 and 20, with brass cap mkd:

 Soil, stony clay loam with same subsoil; 3rd rate.
 No timber.
 Undergrowth, dense sagebrush, good grass for grazing.
 General drainage; S. into Sheep Creek channel, thence W.

September 28:

At 11 h 51 m, a.m., l.m.t., I set off 1°54' S. on the decl. arc; and observe the sun on the meridian; the resulting lat. is 40°51', which is the proper latitude for this point at the cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21. Thence N.0°02'W. between secs. 16 and 17.
 Ascend S. slope of spur, through dense sagebrush.
 6.80 Spur, 86 ft. above sec. cor., projects W., desc.
 22.35 Small stream, 2 lks. wide, 3 ins. deep, in bottom of ravine, 133 ft. below spur, course W., asc.
