

Chains

The course of this half mile is S.0°14'W., and the length 40.35 chs.

Thence from this 1/4 sec. cor., South Over rolling mountainous land, thru dense sagebrush.

70.00 Leave Maggie Creek bottom and begin steep ascent.

75.70 Spur, 50 ft. above 1/4 sec. cor.; projects W., desc.

77.80 Hollow, 25 ft. below spur, course N.80°W., asc.

80.38 Fall 5 lks. E. of the original cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, which is a willow stake 2 ins. in dia., 32 ins. long, with markings obliterated, lying in a mound with traces of pits. I remonument the corner as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

The course of this half mile is S.0°04'W., and the length 40.03 chs.

Land, N. 70 chs. gentle rolling. S. 10 chs. mountainous.

Soil, light, clay loam, 2nd rate; subsoil the same.

No timber.

Undergrowth, rabbit and sagebrush, good grass for grazing.

Drainage West into Maggie Creek.

August 14: At 7 h 0 m, a.m., 1.m.t., I set off 40°49' on the lat. arc; 14°33'N. on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, heretofore described.

Thence East on a true line between secs. 1 and 12 on a resurvey.

Over mountainous land.

Desc. thru sagebrush.

2.30 Hollow, 20 ft. below sec. cor., course NW., asc.

22.80 Ridge, 60 ft. above sec. cor., bears NW. and S., desc.

28.70 Small draw, 25 ft. below ridge, course N.15°E., asc.

29.80 Spur, 10 ft. above draw, projects N., desc.

30.80 Hollow, 10 ft. below spur, course N., asc.

40.00 No trace of 1/4 sec. cor.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 26 ins. in the ground for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Thence

East on a true line on survey of E. 1/2 of mile between secs. 1 and 12.

42.30 Ridge, 15 ft. above 1/4 sec. cor., bears N.20°W. and S.20°E., desc.

44.90 Hollow, 30 ft. below ridge, course W., asc.

59.50 Ridge, 120 ft. above hollow, bears N. and S., desc.

76.50 Hollow, 100 ft. below ridge, course NE., asc.

78.08 Intersect the E. Bdy. at a point N.0°38'E., 1.41 chs. from the cor. of secs. 6 and 7, heretofore described.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 12,
