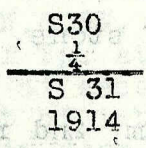
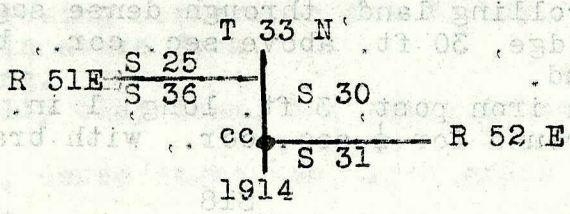


Survey of Subdivisions of T. 33 N., R. 52 E.

Chains  
From the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32 heretofore described, I run  
W. on a true line bet. secs. 30 and 31.  
Over rolling land, through dense sagebrush.  
35.00 W. side of wide hollow, course S. 70°E. ascend spur,  
bears N. E. and S.W.  
40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the  
ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,

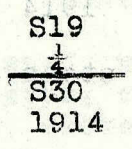


and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high N.  
of corner.  
75.00 Spur, 95 ft. above hollow, bears N. 50°E. and S. 60°W.,  
thence across spur.  
80.51 Intersect W. bdy. of tp. at a point, S. 0° 9'E. 1.54  
chs. distant of the cor. of secs. 25 and 36 heretofore  
described.  
At point of intersection, set an iron post, 3 ft. long,  
2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing cor-  
ner of secs. 30 and 31, with brass cap mkd.,



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high E.  
of corner.  
Land; rolling.  
Soil; gravelly clay loam, 2nd rate, subsoil same.  
No timber.  
Undergrowth; dense sagebrush, good grass for grazing.  
Drainage, E.

From the cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29 and 30 heretofore des-  
cribed I run  
W. on a true line bet. secs. 19 and 30.  
Over rolling land, through dense sagebrush.  
Descend on N. slope of ridge.  
14.80 Wash, 15 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, 10 ft. below sec. cor.,  
course N. 20°E., ascend gently.  
19.90 Ridge, 40 ft. above wash, bears N. 20°E. and S. 20°W.,  
descend.  
40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in  
the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.,



and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high N.  
of corner.  
50.30 A well beaten trail, bears N. E. and S. W.  
62.90 Mary's Creek wash, 3 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, at this  
point N., further down, course N. E., 110 ft. below  
ridge.  
79.90 Intersect W. bdy. of tp. at a point S. 0° 07'W. 2.23 chs.  
dist. from the cor. of secs. 24 and 25 heretofore des-  
cribed.  
At the point of intersection: Set an iron post, 3 ft.  
long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground for closing
