

Chains

- 79.78 200 ft. below ridge.
The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.
Land, high, gravel covered, rolling mountains with a general NW. slope.
Soil, dry, coarse texture, sandy loam soil, shallow and much washed on the slopes. Unfit for cultivation, 3rd and 4th rate.
Good growth sagebrush, considerable grass, weeds and other browse. Good range.
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- 5.70 N.0°01'W. between secs. 1 and 2.
Over high rolling mountains.
Small wash, course NW., 85 ft. below corner.
16.60 Wash, course W., 50 ft. below previous wash. Asc.
29.60 Mountain spur, slopes W., 280 ft. above wash.
Descend NW. slope.
34.70 Head of wash, course W., 60 ft. below spur. Ascend.
40.00 On steep SW. mountain side.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
- 44.80 Mountain spur, slopes W., 105 ft. above wash.
Descend steep slope to Smith Creek.
66.30 Road in Smith Creek, - Smith Creek 6 lks. wide, flows N.60°W., 710 ft. below spur.
Ascend steep slope.
72.11 190 ft. above creek.
Intersect the N. Bdy. of the Tp., at N.89°57'E., 7.55 chs. from the cor. of secs. 35 and 36.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the Closing Corner of secs. 1 and 2, with brass cap mkd:

 C | C
 S2 | S1
 T 29 N
 R 52 E

- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.
Land; high, rolling, gravel covered mountains with a general westerly slope.
Soil, dry, coarse texture, sandy loam soil. Shallow, much washed on the slopes, very gravelly and contains considerable loose volcanic rock and quartz conglomerate rocks, 4th rate.
Good growth sagebrush, considerable grass, weeds and other feed. Good grazing land.

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- June 16, 1915.
At the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., at 9 h 0 m a.m., l.m.t., I set off 40°19'N. on the lat. arc, 23°21'N. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar.
Thence I run
N.0°02'W. between secs. 34 and 35.
Over level table land.
3.50 Edge of table land, bears NE. and SW. Descend.
