

6. Resurvey of S. Bdy. T. 32 N., R. 52 E.

Chains

Sept. 7, 1915.  
At the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, on the South Bdy. of the Tp., at 8 h 0 m a.m., l.m.t., I set off 40°35'N. on the lat. arc, 6°20'N. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar.

I destroy all trace of the old cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, and resurvey it at the same point as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 4 and 5, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, S. of cor.

Thence I resurvey S.88°17'W. on the north bdy. of sec. 5.

Ascend over high volcanic mountains with a general southerly slope.

- 6.50 Top of ascent, 115 ft. above corner; thence over level bench, bears NE. and SW.
- 9.80 Begin ascent of SE. slope.
- 31.50 Top of ascent, 150 ft. above bench; thence over level bench, bears NE. and SW.
- 40.03 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the ¼ sec. cor. for sec. 5, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, S. of cor.

Thence ascend steep rocky SE. slope.

- 60.93 Top of steep ascent, bears NE. and SW., 265 ft. above corner.  
Descend over W. slope.
- 77.91 Small ravine, course S., 250 ft. below top of ascent.
- 80.06 15 ft. above ravine.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, high, rocky, steep volcanic mountains with a general slope to the S. Much slide rock, and outcrops of rock in place, interspersed with small cliffs. A great deal of loose rock on the surface.

Soil; very dry, coarse texture, rocky, 4th rate.

Some sagebrush and other feed, but too rocky for grazing. Land is practically worthless.

S.88°17'W. on the North Bdy. of sec. 6.

- 2.00 Over rough, rocky, volcanic mountains.
- 4.90 Small spur, slopes S. Descend W. slope.
- 10.50 Small draw, course SW. 55 ft. below spur. Ascend.
- 25.00 Rocky mountain spur, slopes S. 90 ft. above draw.  
Descend SW. slope.
- 30.00 Small rocky draw, course NW. 370 ft. below spur.
- 40.03 Small rocky spur, slopes NW. Descend W. slope.  
In small flat.
