

## Retracement of Frac. Subs. T.32 N., R.52 E.

Chains

Sept. 2, 1915.

At the temporary cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16, at 9 h 0 m a.m., l.m.t., I set off  $40^{\circ}38'N.$  on the lat. arc;  $8^{\circ}10'N.$  on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar.

Thence I retrace

East between secs. 10 and 15.

40.00 I search diligently but find no trace of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

80.00 I search diligently but find no trace of the cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15. I set a temporary corner.

From the temporary cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14 and 15, I retrace

South between secs. 14 and 15.

40.00 I search diligently but find no trace of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

80.00 Intersect the temporary cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23, set August 28th. I search again diligently but find no trace of the cor. for secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23.

The sky was overcast with clouds at noon and it was impossible to make an observation for latitude.

From the temporary corner of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23, I retrace

South between secs. 22 and 23.

40.00 I search diligently but find no trace of  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

80.00 I search diligently but find no cor. for secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27. I set a temporary corner.

From the temporary corner of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27, I retrace

East between secs. 23 and 26.

40.00 I search diligently but find no trace of  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

80.00 Intersect the temporary cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26, set August 28th.

I again search diligently but can find no trace of the cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26.

## RESURVEY OF FRAC. W. BDY. T.32 N., R.52 E.

Aug. 30, 1915.

From the cor. of T. 32 N., Rgs. 51 and 52 E.,

$N.0^{\circ}10'W.$ , resurveying between secs. 31 and 36.

Over rolling hills, with a S.W. slope.

19.95 Intersect the cor. that has been erroneously set here for Tps. 31 and 32 N., Rg. 52 E.

I destroy all traces of this corner and its accessories since there should be no such corner here.

33.81 Low mountain spur, slopes SW.

39.89 Intersect the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. for sec. 36.

I set this stone 8 ins. in the ground with the mark  $\frac{1}{4}$  to the west, and repair the mound of stone about the cor.

59.07 Intersect the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. for sec. 31.

I set this stone 7 ins. in the ground, with the mark  $\frac{1}{4}$  to the east, and repair the mound of stone about the corner.

79.91 The cor. of secs. 25 and 36.

I repair the mound of stone about this corner.

On South half mile:

Land, rolling, gravelly and rocky hills, with a slope
