


Chains

- S. slope.
- 34.80 Draw, course SE. 65 ft. below ridge. Ascend NE. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:
- S34 \uparrow S35

- dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
- 41.00 Spur, slopes E., 25 ft. above draw. Descend steep SE. slope.
- 49.06 Deep ravine, course SW., 235 ft. below spur. Ascend NW. slope.
- 52.00 Small spur, slopes W., 70 ft. above ravine.
- 59.50 Small spur, slopes NW., 120 ft. above previous spur. Descend SW. slope.
- 66.17 Small ravine, course NW., 60 ft. below spur. Ascend NW. slope.
- 74.61 Mountain ridge, bears E. and W., 140 ft. above ravine. Descend S. slope.
- 78.15 Ravine, course SW., 75 ft. below ridge. Ascend NW. slope.
- 86.10 Mountain spur, slopes W., 55 ft. above ravine.
- 90.07 Small ravine, course westerly. 75 ft. below spur. Ascend NW. slope.
- 93.00 Small spur, slopes westerly. 70 ft. above ravine. Descend SW. slope.
- 93.95 Intersect the South Bdy. of the Tp., at S.89°55'E., 14.56 chs. from the cor. of secs. 3 and 4.
- Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

Land, high, rolling gravelly and rocky mountains of quartz conglomerate and volcanic rocks, with a general SW. and westerly slope.

Soil, very dry, gravelly and rocky. Shallow and washed on the slopes, 3rd and 4th rate. Unfit for cultivation. Good feed of sagebrush, grass, and weeds. No timber.


Sept. 9, 1915.

At the cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16, at 8 h, a.m., 1.m.t., I set off 40°39'N. on the latitude arc, 5°36'N. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar.

Thence S.0°02'E. between secs. 15 and 16.

Over high, rolling gravelly and rocky mountains. Ascend gradual NW. slope.

- 5.97 Low spur, slopes W. Ascend gradual NW. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

- 42.00 Mountain ridge, bears N.25°E. and S.25°W., 160 ft. above spur. Descend SE. slope.
- 56.70 Ravine, course SW., 170 ft. below ridge.
- 60.22 Ravine, course W.
- 61.72 Small spur, slopes W.
- 64.35 Ravine, course NW. Ascend NE. slope.
