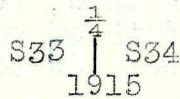


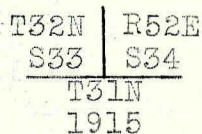
Chains

N. of cor.
 42.48 Small spur, slopes SE., 35 ft. above ravine.
 44.94 Ravine, course SE., 25 ft. below spur. Ascend steep E. slope.
 51.32 Top of steep slope, bears N. and S., 190 ft. above ravine. Ascend more gradually.
 65.72 High mountain spur, slopes SE., 100 ft. above top of steep slope. Descend SW. slope.
 73.18 Ravine, course SE., 215 ft. below spur. Ascend NE. slope.
 76.24 Mountain ridge, bears NW. and SE., 150 ft. above ravine. Descend SW. slope.
 80.34 70 ft. below ridge.
 The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.
 Land, high, rocky and gravelly mountains with a general SW. slope.
 Soil; dry, gravelly and rocky, much washed on the slopes, 3rd and 4th rate. Unfit for cultivation. Good growth of sagebrush, considerable grass, weeds and other feed. No timber, good grazing land.
 At the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34, at about 11 h 57 m a.m., l.m.t., I set off 5°09'N. on the decl. arc, and observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is 40°36'N.

S.0°02'E. between secs. 33 and 34.
 Over high, rolling mountains of volcanic and quartz conglomerate mountains.
 5.94 Small spur, slopes SE., 30 ft. below corner.
 12.72 Large mountain spur, slopes E.
 19.38 Deep ravine, course E., 180 ft. below spur.
 25.80 Ravine, course E., 75 ft. above wash. Ascend NE. slope.
 30.05 Small spur, slopes E., 65 ft. above ravine. Descend S. slope.
 34.03 Head of draw, course E., 25 ft. below spur. Ascend NE. slope.
 39.00 High ridge, bears NW. and SE., 55 ft. above draw. Descend SW. slope.
 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.
 54.15 Deep ravine, course SE., 320 ft. below ridge. Ascend gradually.
 57.60 Point of large spur, slopes E., 40 ft. above ravine. Descend S. slope.
 67.96 Pine Valley and Carlin road, bears NE. and SW.
 69.00 Large ravine, course SW., 95 ft. below spur. Ascend westerly slope.
 89.80 Mountain spur, slopes SW., 135 ft. above ravine. Descend S. slope.
 93.36 Intersect the S. Bdy. of the Tp., at S.89°55'E., 16.74 chs. from the cor. of secs. 4 and 5.
 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, with brass cap mkd:
