- 43.00 High rocky mountain spur, slopes SW., 685 ft. above cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32.
Descend SE. slope.
61.00 Wash, course S., 275 ft. below spur.
68.00 Mountain spur, slopes S., 25 ft. above wash.
Descend SE. slope.
79.50 Ravine, course SW., 280 ft. below spur.
80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, with brass cap mkd:

Land, rocky, rolling limestone and volcanic mountains, with a slope to the SW. and S.
Soil, rocky and gravelly, 4th rate. On E. 70.00 chs. is a thick growth of junipers and scrub pine. Little grass or feed. Very rough, unfit for cultivation.
At about 12 h 2 m, p.m., l.m.t., I set off $23^{\circ}27'N$. on the decl. arc and observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is $40^{\circ}19'N$.

East between secs. 4 and 33.

- 12.50 Over rough mountains, through juniper and scrub pine.
Rocky ridge, bears NE. and SW., 285 ft. above corner.
Thence along S. side of ridge.
40.00 30 ft. above ridge.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:
