Chains

A sheep corral with dipping plant bears N.68°W., 5.30 chs. Land, high, rocky, rolling mountains with a general E. slope. Rocks, mostly volcanic. Soil, dry, shallow, rocky and gravelly, 3rd and 4th rate. Good growth sagebrush, considerable grass, weeds and other feed. Patches of aspen scattered along the streams.

FRAC. E. BDY. T.29 N., R.53 E.

At the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, at about 12 h 4 m p.m., l.m.t., I set off 22°45'N. on the decl. arc, and observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is 40°22'N.

North between secs. 7 and 12.

Over foot of rolling mountains with slope to the E.

2.30 Small stream, 2 lks. wide, course E. Ascend gradually.

9.00 Low ridge, bears E. and W.

12.20 Draw, course E.

18.70 Draw, course E. Ascend gradually.

26.10 Small ridge, bears E. and W., descend gradually.

34.90 Small stream, 3 lks. wide, course E. 60 ft. below ridge. Ascend gradually.

40.00 On ridge, bears E. and W.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

44.00 Draw, course E. Ascend gradually.

60.00 Low spur, slopes E., 50 ft. above draw.

65.30 Draw, course SE., 50 ft. below spur. Ascend gradually.

80.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, ridges and ravines at foot of mountains with easterly slope.

Soil; dry, coarse texture, shallow and washed on the slopes, gravelly and rocky, 2nd and 3rd rate. Too dry for cultivation. Good growth sagebrush, considerable grass, weeds and other feed. Good grazing land.

North between secs. 1 and 6.

Over foot of rolling mountains.

Ascend SE. slope.

13.20 Low mountain spur, slopes NE., 105 ft. above corner.

Descend N. slope.

30.00 Low spur, slopes NE., 140 ft. below previous spur.

34.70 Enter aspen grove, bears E. and W.

36.00 Dixie creek, 5 lks. wide, course E., 175 ft. below spur.

36.50 Leave aspen grove, bears E. and W.

40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:
