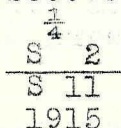


Chains

- 40.00 Set a temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 79.82 Fall 23 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12. Thence West on a true line between secs. 2 and 11. Over high, rocky mountains, sloping SE.
- 2.80 Small spur, slopes N. Descend.
- 18.10 Head of ravine, course SE. 65 ft. below spur. Ascend.
- 25.95 Mountain spur, slopes SE., 130 ft. above ravine.
- 30.15 Draw, course SE.
- 39.91 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

- 40.50 High, rocky mountain spur, slopes SE., 240 ft. above draw.
- 46.40 Deep ravine, course SE., 30 ft. below spur. Ascend.
- 53.85 High, rocky mountain spur, slopes S. 410 ft. above ravine. Descend steep SW. slope.
- 79.82 250 ft. below spur. The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11. Land, high, rocky, quartz conglomerate with metamorphosed sandstone matrix mountains sloping to the SE. Soil, dry, coarse texture, gravelly and rocky, 4th rate. Good growth sagebrush, considerable grass, weeds and other feed. Good grazing land. No timber.

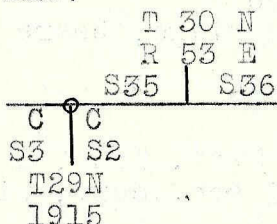
N.0°02'W. between secs. 2 and 3. Over high, rocky mountains. Ascend steep SW. slope.

- 27.60 High mountain ridge, bears E. and W., 230 ft. above corner. Descend N. slope. of mountain.
- 40.00 270 ft. below ridge, in head of draw, course NE. Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

- 50.00 Mountain spur, slopes NE., 45 ft. above draw. Descend NE. slope.
- 57.60 Draw, course NE., 230 ft. below spur.
- 70.00 Mountain spur, slopes NE.
- 76.20 Draw, course NE., 120 ft. below spur.
- 87.12 Intersect the N. Bdy. of the Tp. at N.89°32'W., 23.37 chs. from the cor. of secs. 35 and 36. Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the Closing Corner of Secs. 2 and 3, with brass cap mkd:



and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.

Land, high, rocky, quartz conglomerate mountains with steep slopes. Soil, dry, coarse texture, gravelly and rocky, 3rd and 4th rate. Good growth sagebrush, considerable grass, weeds and other feed. Scattering patches of aspen,
