

## Chains

- East on a random line between secs. 3 and 10.  
 40.00 Set a temporary  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
 80.00 Intersect the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.  
 Thence West on a true line between secs. 3 and 10.  
 1.50 Deep ravine, course SE.  
 Ascend steep E. slope of Smith Creek mountain.  
 40.00 On steep E. slope of mountain.  
 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins.  
 in the ground for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:
- $$\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{4} \\ \text{S } 3 \\ \hline \text{S } 10 \\ 1915 \end{array}$$
- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  
 N. of cor.  
 49.00 High, rocky mountain ridge, bears N. and S., 740 ft.  
 above ravine. Descend. gradual W. slope.  
 55.00 Draw, course N., 45 ft. below ridge. Ascend gradual E.  
 slope.  
 75.00 Top of Smith Creek Mountain, bears N. and S., 50 ft.  
 above draw.  
 Descend gradual W. slope.  
 80.00 65 ft. below mountain top.  
 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.  
 Land, high, rocky mountain.  
 Soil, dry, gravelly and rocky, 4th rate. Good growth of  
 sagebrush, considerable grass, weeds and other feed.  
 Scattering patches of aspen, buckbrush and mountain  
 mahogany.  
 Good grazing land.

At the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10, at about 12 h  
 5 m p.m., l.m.t., I set off  $22^{\circ}19'N$ . on the decl. arc,  
 and observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting  
 latitude is  $40^{\circ}24'N$ .

$N.0^{\circ}02'W$ . between secs. 3 and 4.

Along W. slope of mountain.

- 9.00 Begin descent of N.W. slope.  
 14.50 Enter grove of scrub aspen, bears E. and W.  
 28.00 Leave grove of scrub aspen, bears E. and W.  
 35.70 Rocky mountain spur, slopes NW., 470 ft. below top of  
 descent. Continue descent.  
 36.50 Edge of slide rock, bears E. and W. Descend over  
 slide rock.  
 39.50 Leave slide rock, bears E. and W.  
 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in  
 the ground for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

$$\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{4} \\ \text{S4 } | \text{ S3} \\ 1915 \end{array}$$

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  
 W. of cor.

Continue descent of mountain.

- 47.00 Pass over small cliffs, bear E. and W., 220 ft. below  
 spur.  
 Continue descent.  
 51.00 Enter grove of scrub aspen, bears NW. and SE.  
 58.40 Leave aspen grove, bears E. and W.  
 70.50 Enter bushes bears E. and W.  
 74.10 Leave bushes, bears E. and W.  
 88.22 940 ft. below cliffs.

Intersect the N. Bdy. of the Tp., at  $N.89^{\circ}46'W$ .,  
 23.01 chs. from the cor. of secs. 34 and 35.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins.  
 in the ground for the Closing Corner of Secs. 3 and 4,  
 with brass cap mkd:
