

Chains

I destroy all trace of this corner and its accessories and reestablish it at the same point as follows:

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, with brass cap mkd:

R 54 E
S33 | S34

T 29 N

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.
Land, rocky, rolling volcanic mountains with a slope to the SE.
Soil, dry, gravelly and rocky. Shallow and much washed on the slopes, 3rd and 4th rate. Too dry, rough and gravelly for cultivation.
Good feed for grazing, consisting of some grass, weeds and other browse and a good growth of sagebrush.
No timber.

July 17, 1915.

At the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, on the W. Bdy. of the Tp., at 8 h 0 m, a.m., l.m.t., I set off 40°23'N. on the lat. arc, 21°20'N. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar.

Thence East between secs. 7 and 18.

Descend gradual NE. slope.

- 10.48 Small creek, 3 lks. wide, course SE. 55 ft. below corner.
- 15.20 Small rocky spur, slopes S. Descend NE. slope.
- 32.10 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course NE. 85 ft. below spur.
- 39.00 Small spur, slopes NE.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.

- 40.30 Rocky ravine, course NE. Ascend.
- 48.00 Low rocky spur, slopes N., 35 ft. above ravine. Descend NE. slope.
- 50.00 Descend over cliffs 50 ft. high, bears NW. and SE.
- 53.40 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course SE. 85 ft. below spur. Ascend.
- 55.60 Small rocky spur, slopes S. 35 ft. above creek. Desc.
- 59.80 Draw, course SE. 25 ft. below spur.
- 63.00 Point of rocky spur, slopes SE.
- 65.05 Draw, course S.
- 73.00 Low rocky spur, slopes S. 15 ft. above draw. Descend.
- 75.00 Ravine, course SW., 20 ft. below spur. Ascend NW. slope.
- 80.00 60 ft. above ravine.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18, with brass cap mkd:
