Chains

- and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.
- 55.00 Rocky, cliffy mountain spur, slopes N., 170 ft. above draw. Descend E. slope.
- 80.00 On NE. slope. 310 ft. below spur.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, with brass cap mkd:

dig pits 18x18x12 ins. in each section 6 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, rolling rocky, volcanic mountains with a general NE. slope.

Soil, very dry, gravelly and rocky, shallow and much washed on the slopes; derived from the disintegration of volcanic rock, 3rd and 4th rate. Too dry and rocky for cultivation.

Good growth of sagebrush, considerable grass, weeds and other browse. No timber. Good grazing land.

- N.0°02'E. between secs. 4 and 5.
- Over rolling, rocky volcanic mountains with a slope to the SE.
- 1.10 Draw, course E.
- 7.00 Small spur, slopes E., 15 ft. above draw. Ascend gradually.
- 14.00 Small draw, course NE., 95 ft. below spur.
- 20.30 Ridge, bears NE. and SW. Descend N. slope.
- 24.00 Small stream in ravine, 4 lks. wide, course E. 30 ft. below ridge.
Ascend S. slope.
- 25.50 Low mountain spur, slopes E., 30 ft. above creek.
- 29.75 Ravine, course SE., 25 ft. below spur. Ascend steep SW. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

Continue ascent of SW. slope.

- 55.10 Rocky mountain spur, slopes SE., 325 ft. above ravine. Thence along E. slope.
- 60.30 Head of small draw, course SE.
- 78.00 Low spur, slopes NE. 70 ft. above draw. Descend NE. slope gradually.
- 81.70 Small draw, course E., 30 ft. below spur. Ascend gradually.
- 83.21 Intersect the N. Bdy. of the Tp., at N.89°17'W.; 23.98 chs. from the cor. of secs. 33 and 34.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the closing corner of secs. 4 and 5, with brass cap mkd:
