Chains

I return to the cor. of Tps. 34 and 35 N., Rgs. 55 and 56 E., and at about 11 h 55 m, a.m., l.m.t., set off $2^{\circ} 51' N.$ on the decl. arc and observe the sun on the meridian the resulting latitude is $40^{\circ} 50' 30'' N.$

Thence I retrace

East between secs. 6 and 31, on the N. Bdy. of the Tp.

40.00 I search diligently but find no $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

85.20 I find the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, falling 1.48 chs. South of line.

The course of this line is $S. 89^{\circ} E.$, and the length 85.21 chs. Sept. 16, 1915.

RETRACEMENT OF W. BDY. T. 34 N. R. 56 E.
RUBY VALLEY GUIDE MERIDIAN.

Sept. 17, 1915.

At 8 h 0 m, a.m., l.m.t., at the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, on the W. Bdy. of the Tp., I set off $40^{\circ} 49' N.$ on the lat. arc, $2^{\circ} 32' N.$ on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar.

Thence I retrace

South between secs. 13 and 18.

40.00 I search diligently but find no $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.00 I search diligently but find no cor. for secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24. Set a temporary corner.

From the temporary cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, South on a retracement between secs. 19 and 24.

40.00 I search diligently but find no $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.00 I search diligently but find no cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30. Set a temporary corner.

At this point at about 11 h 55 m, a.m., l.m.t., I set off $2^{\circ} 28' N.$ on the decl. arc and observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is $40^{\circ} 47' N.$

From the temporary cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, South on a retracement between secs. 25 and 30.

40.00 I search diligently but find no $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.00 I search diligently but find no cor. for secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36. Set a temporary corner.

From the temporary cor. for secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, South on a retracement between secs. 31 and 36.

40.00 I search diligently but find no $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

82.68 Intersect the cor. of Tps. 33 and 34 N., Rgs. 55 and 56 E. A pine post 4x4 ins. by 3 ft. above ground, firmly set in the ground in a mound of earth and stone and marked with 6 notches on each of the N., S., E. and W. edges.

October 4, 1915.

At the cor. of Tps. 34 and 35 N., Rgs. 55 and 56 E., at 9 h 0 m, a.m., l.m.t., I set off $40^{\circ} 50' 30'' N.$ on the lat. arc, $4^{\circ} 5' S.$ on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar.

I now reestablish the cor. of Tps. 34 and 35 N., Rgs. 55 and 56 E., as follows: at the point where the old corner originally was.
