Resurvey of 7th Std.Par.N., thru R. 56 E.

Chains

80.80 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the standard cor. of secs. 34 and 35, with brass cap mkd:

dig pits 24x18x12 ins. E. and W. 3 ft. and N. of post 7 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

On west half mile:

Land rolling with a general SE. slope.

Soil, dry, coarse texture, sandy and somewhat gravelly desert loam from 1 to 2 feet in depth; too dry for cultivation, 1st and 2nd rate. Good growth sagebrush, considerable grass, weeds and other feed. No timber, fair grazing land.

East on the 7th Standard Parallel North, on the south bdy. of sec. 35.

40.40 Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:
