

Retracement of Fractional E. Bdy. T.35 N.,R.56 E.

Chains

Oct. 28, 1915.

At the cor. of T. 35 N., Rgs. 56 and 57 E., on the 7th Standard Parallel North, which cor. is a redwood post 3x4 ins. by 2 ft. above ground, firmly set in the ground and marked with 6 notches on the E., W. and S. edges, and bears from the standard cor. of T.36 N., Rgs. 56 and 57 E., west 3.10 chs., at 8 h 0 m a.m., l.m.t. I set off 40°56'N. on the lat. arc, 12°51'S. on the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar.

Thence I retrace

South between secs. 1 and 6, on the East Bdy. of the Tp.

I search diligently but find no 1/4 sec. cor.

80.00

I search diligently but find no cor. for secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12.

The course of this mile is south.

October 28, 1915.

RESURVEY OF FRACTIONAL E. BDY. T.35 N.R.56 E.

Oct. 29, 1915.

At the cor. of T.35 N., Rgs. 56 and 57 E., on the 7th Standard Parallel North, at 9 h 0 m, a.m., l.m.t., I set off 40°56'N. on the lat. arc, 13°13'S. on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar.

I remove the old cor. of T. 35 N., Rgs. 56 and 57 E., and at the same point set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of T.35 N., Rgs. 56 and 57 E., with brass cap mkd:

dig pits 30x24x12 ins. crosswise on line E. and W. 4 ft. and S. of post 8 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 5 ft. base, 2 1/2 ft. high, S. of cor.

Thence I resurvey

South between secs. 1 and 6, on the E. Bdy. of the Tp.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd:

dig pits 18x18x12 ins. N. and S. of cor. 3 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth 3 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.

Over level land in the Humboldt River bottom.

South bank of Humboldt River, bears E. and W.

Telegraph line, bears N.75°W. and S.75°E.

64.70

Telegraph line, bears N.75°W. and S.75°E.

66.30

Southern Pacific Railroad track, bears N.75°W. and S.75°E.

67.30

Telegraph line, bears N.75°W. and S.75°E.

69.40

Western Pacific Railroad track, bears N.70°W. and S.70°E.

70.30

Western Pacific right of way fence, bears N.70°W. and S.70°E.

70.40

Telegraph line, bears N.70°W. and S.70°E.

77.30

Enter willows, bears NW. and SE.

77.70

Leave willows, bears NW. and SE., begin ascent of foot of hill.

80.00

Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 1 and 6, on the east bdy. of the township, with brass cap mkd:
