Chains

- 49.00 Mountain spur, slopes NE., 125 ft. above ravine.  
Descend N. slope.
- 63.55 Ravine, course NE., 160 ft. below spur. Ascend.
- 70.00 Mountain spur, slopes NE., 25 ft. above ravine.  
Descend N. slope.
- 73.70 Ravine, course NE., 140 ft. below spur. Ascend gradually.
- 81.44 Fall 2.92 chs. W. of the cor. of secs. 1 and 6, on the  
E. Bdy. of the Tp.  
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins.  
in the ground for the cor. of secs. 7 and 12, with  
brass cap mkd:

dig pits 24x24x12 ins. in each section 6 ft. dist.,  
and raise a mound of earth 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high,  
S. of cor.

Land, rolling mountains of deep ravines and steep ridges  
with a slope to the NE., made up of quartz pebble con-  
glomerate rocks as a foundation, very gravelly.

Soil, very dry, coarse texture, sandy and gravelly.

Shallow and washed on the slopes, 3rd and 4th rate.

Unfit for cultivation. Good growth sagebrush, fair feed  
of some grass, weeds and other herbage. No timber.

Fair grazing land.

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RETRACEMENT OF FRAC. SUBS. T.35 N., R. 56 E.

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Sept. 22, 1915.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. Bdy.  
of the Tp., I retrace

North between secs. 31 and 32.

40.32 I find the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., falling 12 lks. W. of line.

It is a cedar stake, 1 in. in dia., by 18 ins.  
long, lying on the ground on an old mound of earth,  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$ .

Course of this  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile is N.0°10'W.

From the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. I retrace North.

40.89 I find the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, falling 34  
lks. E. of line.

A willow stake 2x2 ins. by 20 ins. long, above ground,  
set in the ground in an old mound of earth, squared at  
the top, the markings have been obliterated by weathering.

Course of this line is N.0°29'E.

Oct. 2, 1915.

At the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, at 8 h. a.m.,  
l.m.t., I set off 40°51'N. on the lat. arc, 3°17'S. on  
the decl. arc, and determine a meridian with the solar.  
Thence I retrace

East between secs. 29 and 32.

40.00 I search diligently but find no  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the W.  
Bdy. of the Tp.,

I retrace

East between secs. 30 and 31.

38.25 I search diligently but find no  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

84.91 Fall 1.14 chs. S. of the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.

Course of this mile is N.89°14'W. and the length 84.92 chs.
