The cor. of secs. 29 and 32.
Land, rolling at foot of mountains and NW. slope of mountains.
Soil, dry, coarse texture, sandy and somewhat gravelly desert loam, with considerable loose rocks on the mountain slope, 2nd and 3rd rate. Unfit for cultivation. Fair feed of sagebrush, some grass, weeds and other feed.
No timber.

At the cor. of secs. 29 and 32, at about 11 h 50 m a.m., l.m.t., I set off 3°22'N. on the decl. arc and observe the sun on the meridian, the resulting latitude is 40°50'N.
Thence I survey
South between secs. 32 and 33.
Ascend NW. slope of high, rocky mountains.
On NW. slope of mountains.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the ¼ sec. cor. for sec. 32, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.
High mountain spur, slopes SW., 650 ft. above corner of secs. 29 and 32.

Ravine, course SW., 70 ft. below spur. Ascend NW. slope.

Summit of mountains, bears SW. and NE., 105 ft. above ravine.

Intersect the S. bdy. of the Tp., at E. 4.92 chs. from the cor. of secs. 4 and 5.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the cor. of secs. 32 and 33, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.
Land, high, rocky mountains of quartz pebble conglomerates and other sedimentaries.
Soil, dry, rocky and gravelly, 3rd and 4th rate. Unfit for cultivation. Fair feed of sagebrush, some grass, weeds and other browse. No timber.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the S. Bdy. of the Tp.,
East on a true line on the S. Bdy. of the Tp.
Set an iron post 3 ft. long, 1 in. in dia., 24 ins. in the ground for the ¼ sec. cor. for sec. 32, with brass cap mkd:

and raise a mound of stone 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.
North on a random line between secs. 3 and 4.
Intersect the S. Bdy. of sec. 33, on the 7th Standard Parallel North, at N.89°56'W., 8.28 chs. from the standard cor. of secs. 33 and 34.
